



This ready-to-run HO scale model represents a series of five gondola cars CRANDIC had on its roster. Numbered 320 through 324, they were built in 1935. As of 1970, these cars were painted traction yellow, and sported large red CRANDIC lettering on the sides. The model was created in cooperation with the Cedar Rapids and Iowa City Railway Company, especially for the 2010 Mid-Continent Regional convention of the National Model Railroad Association. Among the model's features are: individual formed wire grab irons, sharp and accurate lettering, metal wheels, decals for all five car numbers, and a realistic simulated scrap metal load. It's an eye-catching model that will be right at home on any HO scale model train layout, or stand on its own as an attractive display piece.
